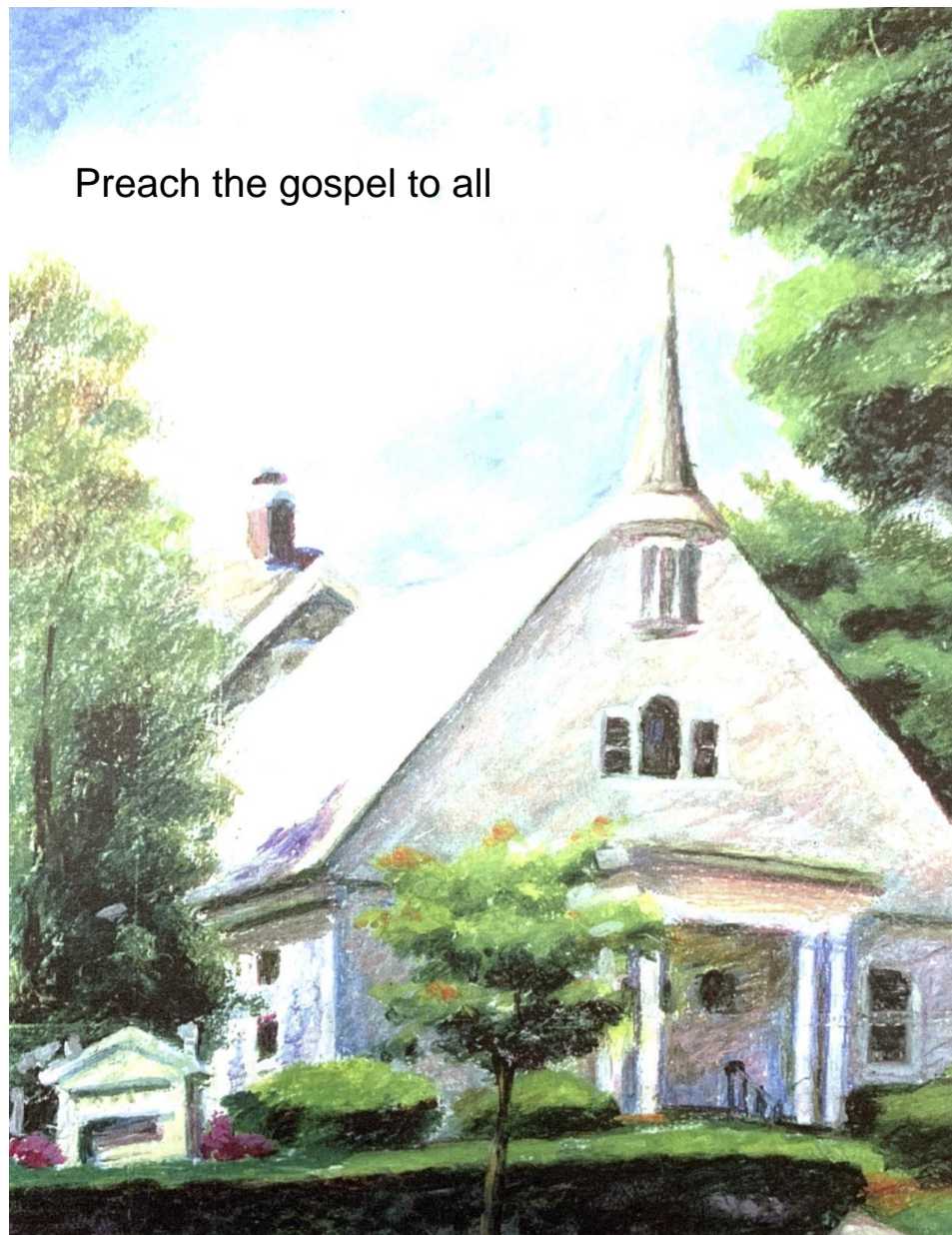


Prayer Items

Year-to-date, the income stands at \$307.6K, expenses at \$293.5K, creating a surplus of \$14.1K. The Great Commission Fund has collected \$13K year-to-date.
