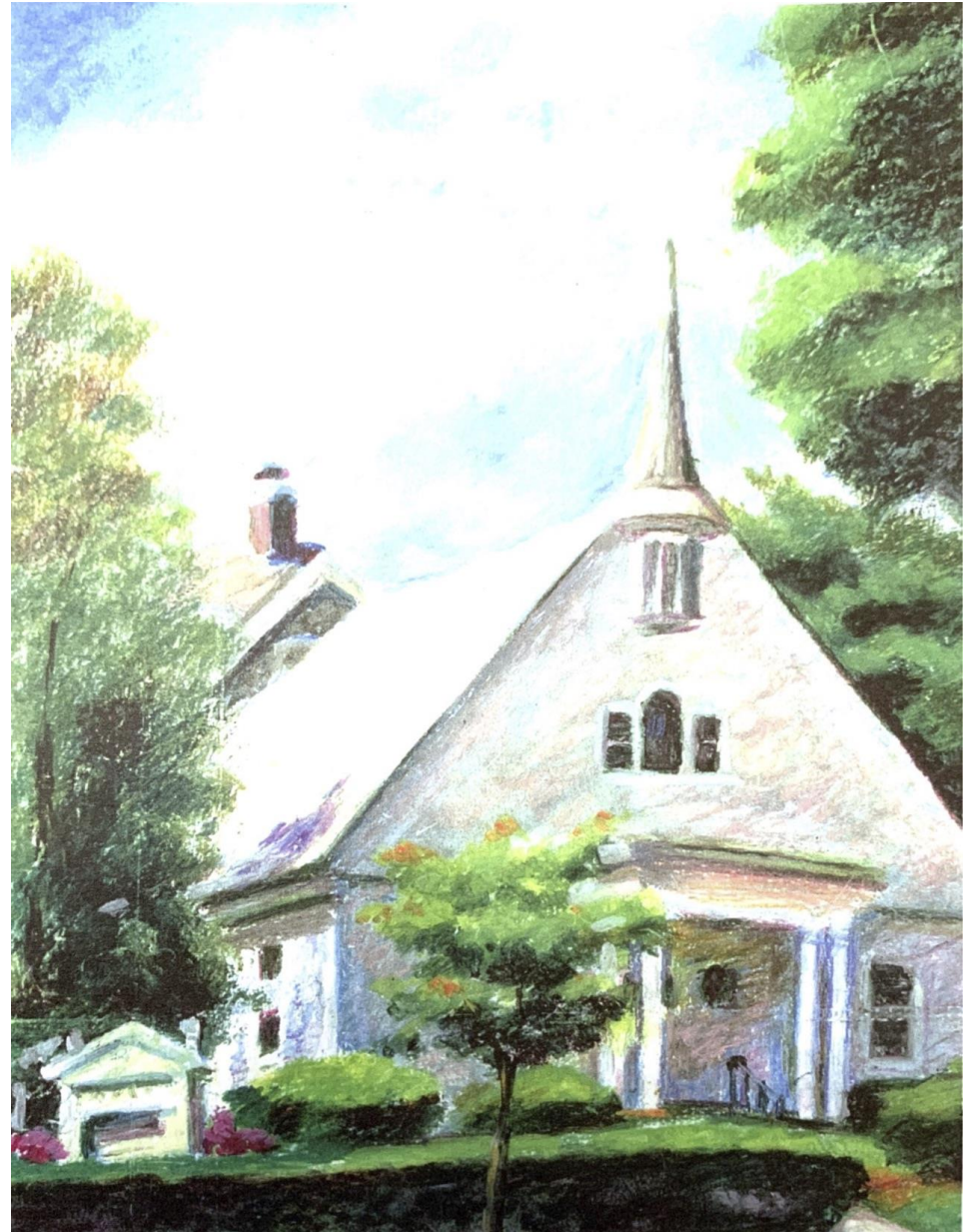


Prayer Items
