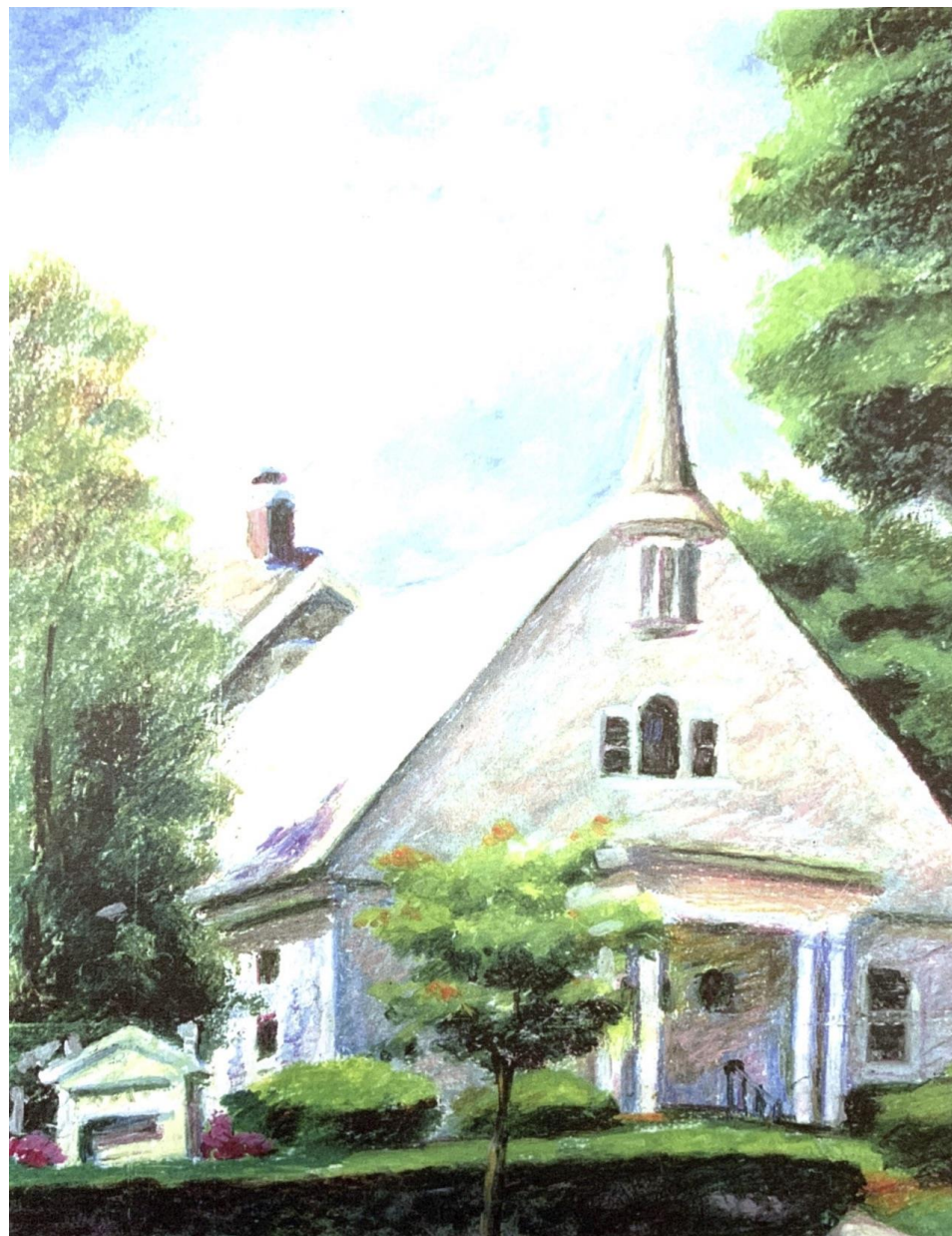


Prayer Items
