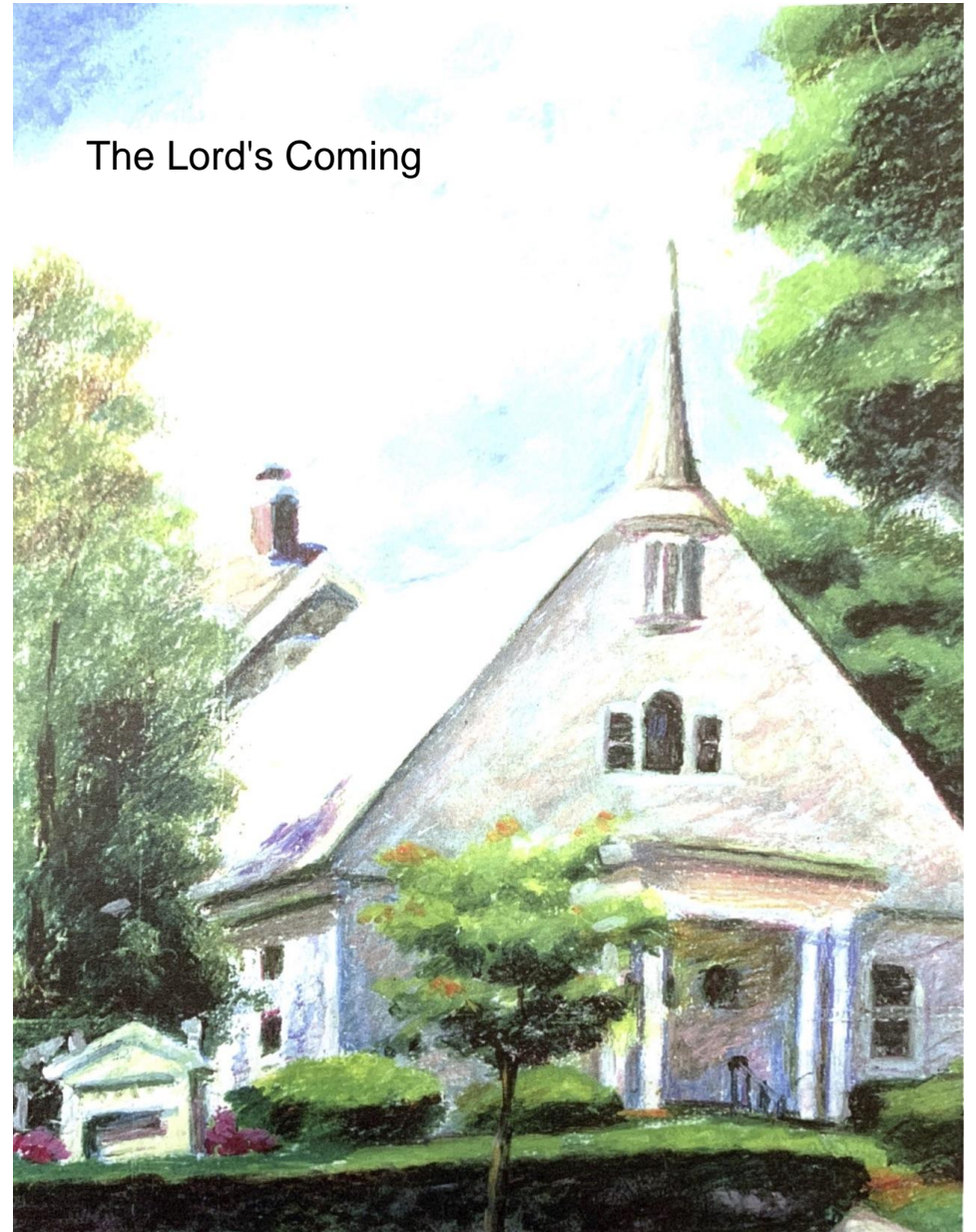


Prayer Items

1. Please pray for the invitation and weather for the 3/15 Gospel Rally event, and pray for God to bless us!
2. Here at the start of 2025, our new annual theme is "The Lord's Coming" (Titus 2:13). Please pray that God will renew our hope in Christ alone!
3. Let's continue to pray for people who are suffering or mourning the loss of loved ones as a result of the many recent natural disasters and large-scale accidents. May God provide help, comfort, and an increased awareness of His love and goodness.
4. Pray for people in parts of the country that are faced with extreme cold. Pray for safety--especially for those who do not have warm places to stay. May God bless and help them, and make himself known to them.
5. Pray for our young people studying in college. Pray for good rest and refreshment during their holiday break. And as they prepare to return to school, please pray for God's peace, joy, encouragement, and strength to be upon them. Pray for a joyful transition into school life, and also that God would draw these young people into an even closer walk with Jesus.
6. Please pray that brothers and sisters will invite new friends to church to attend Sunday worship and bring others to hear the gospel so that they might come to know the truth, and experience rebirth and salvation. Please pray for the salvation of new friends!
7. Pray for God's mercy regarding conflict and violence throughout the world--including, of course, the conflict between Israel, Hamas, Hezbollah, and Iran, for families in anguish, for political leaders, and for peace.
8. Please pray for the church's fellowships. Some groups, such as the Sisters' Fellowship and Rock Fellowship, have daily Bible reading. 10. Please pray for our church's Governing Board, that God would give them spiritual wisdom to effectively serve our church. Pray also for our church's corporate decision-making as we gather today for our annual year-end membership meeting. Pray especially for those coworkers who were recently elected -- Guo Hong as incoming Missions Coworker, and Pei Yeh and Gavin Lam who were elected to second terms as Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer, respectively.
11. Praise the Lord that there are many new young people attending our Youth Group. Please pray that our Youth Group members will continue to be drawn into a closer and closer knowledge of God, and a deeper walk with Jesus.
12. Pray for marriages and families that are experiencing conflict. May God use challenging moments as opportunities for families to grow close to Christ and to one another!
13. Please pray that brothers and sisters will have the desire to study God's words, that they not only have regular devotional time but also intimate time with God, that they'd be able to use their gifts to serve God, to benefit others and to glorify our King!
