
Prayer Items

Please pray that the Lord will nurture and grow the seeds planted last night and this morning, and that many will recognize the salvation available to them in Christ and turn their hearts to the Lord!
- 2. Here at the start of 2025, our new annual theme is "The Lord's Coming" (Titus 2:13). Please pray that God will renew our hope in Christ alone!
- 3. The Muslim world is observing Ramadan, a significant month of prayer and fasting in the Islamic faith. This year's Ramadan started on February 28. We would like to encourage you pray for the Muslim world during the Ramadan period. May our Lord bring open hearts to God's love, revelation and truth, peace, blessings and provision, relationship and understanding to our Muslim friends.
