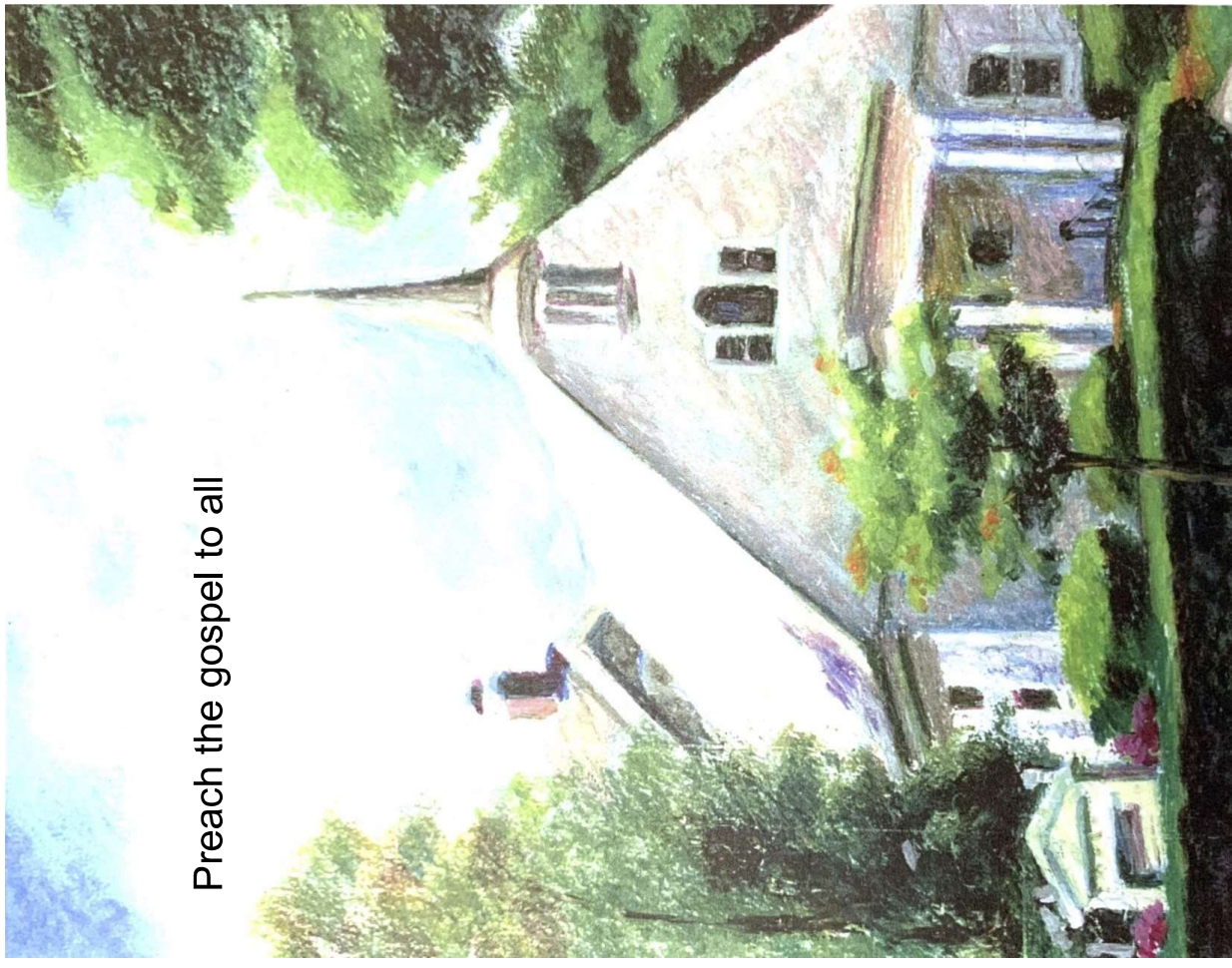


Prayer Items
