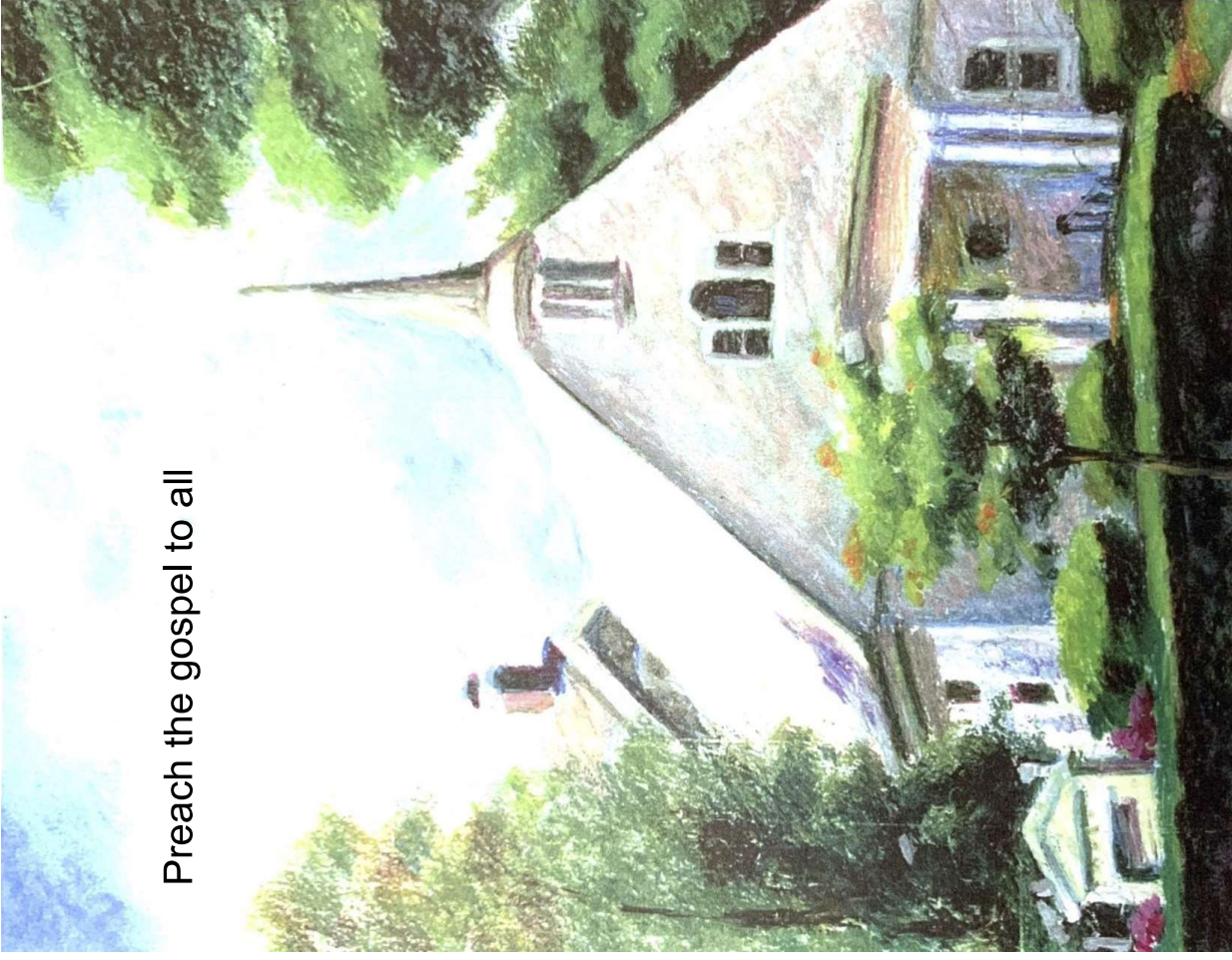


## Prayer Items
